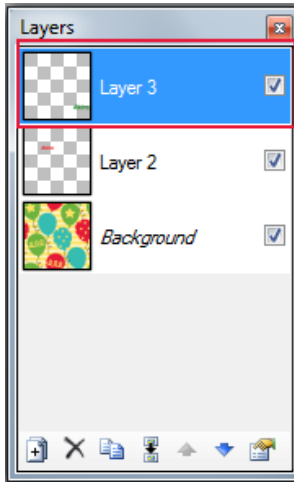
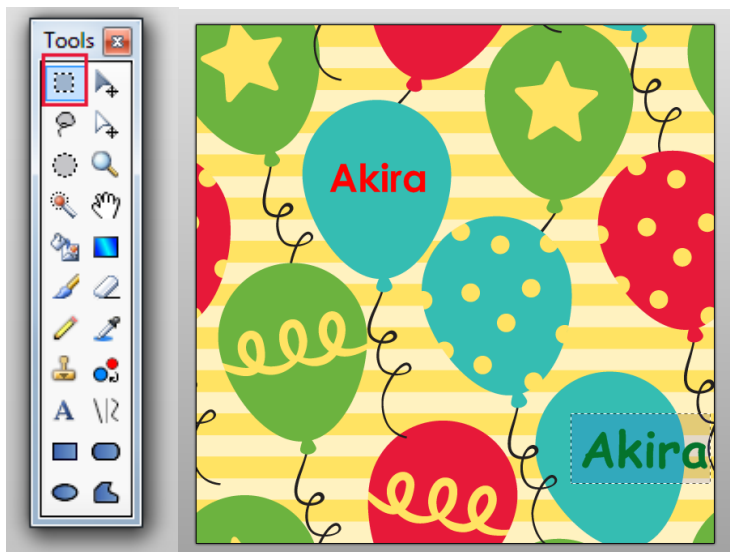


Editing your Text

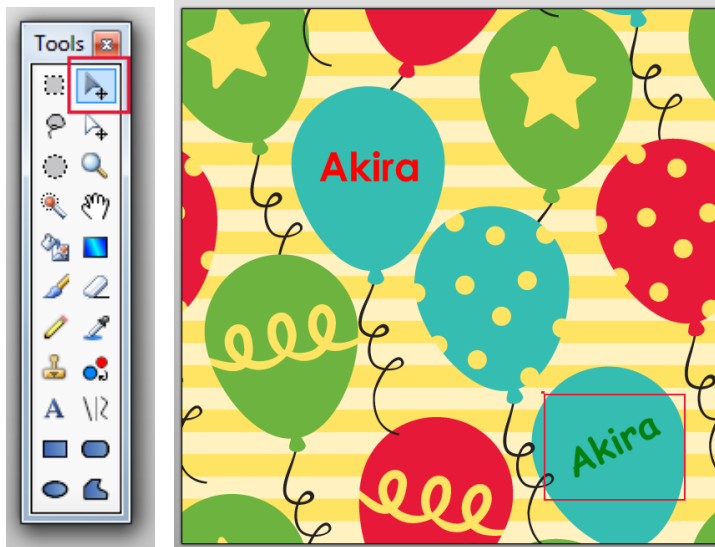
- Before you start to edit your text make sure you are on the correct layer in the **Layer Box**. If you are not sure you're on the correct layer you can uncheck the box to the right, and if your text disappears, you know you're starting your edit in the correct place. Recheck the box.



- **Select Rectangle Select Tool for the Tool Box**/Place cursor over text you wish to edit and draw a box around the text. Notice dots are going around name.



- Using the **Move Pixel Tool**/you will now be able to **move/rotate/expand/decrease text**. To view how to rotate/move/expand/decrease text watch the Video on the Resource Page of our website titled **“Adding Text to your Image”**.



- Once your editing is complete you will need to save your design. First make sure you have setup a folder for projects. **Select/Save As** (make sure you are in the correct folder)-(also you might want to rename your project)/**.png or FS** (to maintain layers)/**flatten layers**. If I am working on a large project I will save the design or project in both a .png and FS file. Save first as the FS File, then save as .png.
- Now you are ready to **repeat design/or send your completed project to the printer**.
